Kleberg-Kenedy County AgriLife Extension Service complies with the law set forth by legislature regarding eligibility and school absences. Members competing or simply participating in a 4-H event (judging events, presentations, livestock shows, etc.) must be certified as eligible to participate by their respective school. School Officials will be provided with a list of students entered in competitive/noncompetitive 4-H events. Should a student be ineligible according to their school, 4-H members will be notified in writing of their ineligibility statues by our office.
